I am not a serving member of the British armed forces and the content of this is based upon a considerable amount of time spent researching the topics and talking with active personnel in the British armed forces. This is intended to represent the most accurate and practical representation of British forces within ArmA based on the information that has been made available to me and in no way do I claim this is exactly how things are in any particular branch of the British armed forces.

Introduction.

The following document is intended to act as a guide for mission makers intending to create realistic orbats and loadouts for British forces through the 1970's to the present day.

The recommended gear is a general idea of what individuals should be carrying and can change depending on specific units SOPs, mission situation etc.

With the British armed forces being what they are, there are some terminology differences between branches and specific units below is a brief explanation of these as far as the scope of ArmA realistically allows.

- Fire Team (Charlie, Delta, Gun group)
- Section (Army, Royal Marines, Royal Artillery)
- Platoon (Army) Troop (Army mortars, Royal Marines, Royal Artillery, Cavalry) Flight (RAF Reg.)
- Company (Army, Royal Marines) Battery (Royal Artillery, Army mortars) Squadron (Cavalry, RAF Reg.)
- Battalion (Army) Commando (Royal Marines) Group (RAF Reg.)

While the Army uses letters for company names and numbers for platoon names, the Royal Marines use numbers for both their Commando names and Troop names.
